9/8/2022

President Wendy called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm welcoming 12 members, 3 guests and Northwood Community Center spokesperson, Laura Danford.

Meeting Minutes 8/11/2022 - Diantha - Correction "Nominations at November 2022 meeting for 2023". The office of Secretary was stated open for re-election for 2023 however, there is one year left on that term. A motion by Erica, seconded by Kelly to approve the 8/11/2023 minutes was made with the correction. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report, August 2022 -Sherri - The Treasurer's Report was emailed to the membership 9/5/2022. Beginning balance \$16,612.20, income \$237.00, expenses \$212.00, outstanding checks \$25.00. Facility Rent \$22.47, Charity Quilts and \$2,911.00 Fall Retreat ending balance = \$13,865.73. A motion by Julie, seconded by Susan to approve the August 2022 Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor.

Fall Retreat - October 20-23, 2022 Haw River State Park - Sherri - For those attending the retreat, Sherri will be sending out the final details soon. The 2023 Retreat October 19-22, 2023 has been booked. Registration information will be available soon.

Jamestown Village Fair at Mendenhall Homeplace will be held Saturday September 17, 2022. President Wendy stated the Guild was invited to vendor for the occasion. We normally sell tickets for our raffle quilt at this event, but due to the Pandemic we held our raffle quilt drawing in May 2022. The new raffle quilt will be ready for next year's event. It was suggested we still participate and do demonstrations such as appliqué, hand quilting, knitting, crochet, etc. We also have boutique items available that we could sell. If anyone is interested in volunteering, the hours are 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Please contact Wendy.

Program - Northwood Community Center - Laura Danford - Laura gave an overview about what the Center does to help those in need in the community. They also work closely with other organizations in the area on programs and needs. At Northwood Community Center, the first Monday of each month is a free community dinner served on site, and those that attend are allowed to shop the Clothes Closet and Food Pantry.
