A little birdie has informed me that some members were discussing disappointment with the category changes at the Carolina Classic Fair in the Competitive Entry section of the fair book. I am a member of the Forsyth Piecers and Quilters Guild and was led to understand that the Guild fought for years to change some of the competitive categories to better align with the categories at state and national quilt shows. While the Quilt category is still listed in Dept. Q (there are miniature quilts in this category), mini doll quilts and wall hangings are listed in Dept. R under Adult and Senior Handcrafts. There are Knit and Crochet categories as well. My understanding was that the Dual Quilt entry was the most wanted addition, for those who want to enter something that was pieced by one person and quilted by another. If you have trouble finding the category you are used to or want to know in which category your object falls, I would be glad to try to research it, if you will send me an email.
