Beginning balance \$15,337.08, deposits \$314.00, checks cleared \$128.55, outstanding checks \$500.00, ending balance \$15,022.53. A motion by Nancy Blanchard seconded by Juanita Hale to approve the November 2021 Treasurer's Report was submitted. All in favor.

2022 HPQG Budget - Sherri informed everyone that the 2022 budget has been completed and will be reviewed and voted on at the Guild's regular meeting on January 13, 2022.

Block of the Month, Janet Wells –

2022 Block of the Month: Star Shine, Star Bright

With this being our tenth anniversary year, we are going to let our stars shine. This BOM will be a little different. Instead of a block each month, you'll receive two blocks every other month. One block will be traditionally pieced and the other will be paper pieced. Each of the block patterns will be from Quilter's Cache.

Several of the blocks will require only two fabrics. But fabric selection is strictly up to you! All blocks will be 12 inches finished.

For the paper-pieced blocks, there is a link to the template located in the top right corner of the page. We will have a paper piecing workshop at our April meeting.

To start off our celebration year, we are starting off with the Friendship Star, and Double Star which is a friendship star variation.

*These block directions will come as a separate email entitled "Janet's Challenge".

Ugly Fabric Challenge –

Rules for the Ugly Fabric Challenge

1. It must be a "traditional" quilt – it should have a top, middle and back.
 2. At least 30 percent of the quilt must use the fabric given out for the challenge.
 3. The challenge fabric cannot be used as the binding or backing.
 4. The quilt can be no larger than 42-inches by 42-inches and no smaller than 24-inches x 24-inches. The measurements can fall anywhere in these parameters (in other words, it could measure something like 30-inches x 24-inches).
 5. Quilts are due by the Summer Potluck in July, which is July 14, 2022.

2022 Drop Everything and Just Quilt Retreat

Please read the following registration form carefully. There have been several changes since the last time (2019) we had an overnight quilt retreat at Haw River State Park in Brown Summit, NC. **The retreat is scheduled for October 20 – 23, 2022. Please check your calendar before committing to the retreat.**

The prices are as follows:

Single room, three nights -- \$350.00

Single room, two nights -- \$235.00

Single room, one night -- \$130.00

Double room, three nights -- \$280.00

Double room, two nights -- \$190.00

Double room, one night -- \$100.00

Day Campers -- \$25.00 per day. Fee includes lunch only Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

For those overnight campers who are arriving early on Thursday, please note your lunch for Thursday is no longer included in the cost. If you plan to eat lunch in the park on Thursday, please add \$12.00 to your cost. Dinner is included for Thursday.

Single rooms occupancy is limited and available on a first come, first serve basis. Deposits can be made at guild meetings or mailed to High Point Quilt Guild, PO Box 2036, Jamestown, NC, in care of the Guild Treasurer. Checks or money orders should be made out to High Point Quilt Guild.

A \$60.00 deposit is required for all overnight campers. This fee is nonrefundable and is due by January 1, 2022. The balance is due by July 15 and is also non-refundable. Day campers should also have their fees paid by July 15.
