High Point Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes January 13, 2022

President Wendy Clagg called the Zoom meeting to order at 6:30pm welcoming fourteen members and our guest speaker, Gloria Stickney of Sew Fabulous Quilts. January birthday greetings were given.

December 2021 Minutes - Diantha Dann, Secretary - A motion by Sherri Fields, seconded by Alicia Carter to approve the minutes was submitted. All in favor.

December 2021 Treasurer's Report - Sherri Fields - The Treasurer's Report was emailed to the membership January 5, 2022. Beginning balance \$15,522.53, checks and payments \$117.34, deposits \$927.00, uncleared checks and payments \$1,312.61, uncleared deposits and credits \$270.00, current balance \$15,289.58. A motion by Karen Tooley and seconded by Janet Wells to accept the Treasurer's Report was submitted. All in favor.

2022 HPQG Proposed Budget - Sherri Fields - Emailed to the membership January 5, 2022. Sherri explained that the only increase in the 2022 budget is the Hospitality category. The Guild's Ten-Year Anniversary party scheduled for April 2, 2022 required the Hospitality increase. The remainder of the budget remains the same as for 2021. A motion by Angie Peele, seconded by Alicia Carter approving the HPQG 2022 budget was submitted. All in favor.
