Meeting Minutes via Zoom  
11/10/2022

President Wendy called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm welcoming 18 members and guests Sue R. and our program presenter Diane H. also known as the "Stash Bandit". November birthday wishes were given.

Meeting Minutes - Diantha, Secretary - A motion by Nancy, seconded by Sherri to approve the October 13, 2022 meeting minutes was made. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report – Sherri, Treasurer - The Treasurer's report was emailed to the membership on 11/5/2022. October 2022 beginning balance \$13,956.73, expenses \$560.44 (printing and copying \$35.44 and programs \$525.00), ending balance \$13,396.29. A motion by Angie, seconded by Elizabeth to approve the October 2022 Treasurer's Report was made. All in favor.

Program - Susan introduced Diane, aka the "Stash Bandit". Diane is a teacher, designer and was an editor for Quiltmaker Magazine for 11 years. Diane presented an excellent program on how to use your stash to make quilts, along with a beautiful trunk show of quilts she has made from her stash. The keyword she goes by when choosing fabric for a quilt is "Value"; dark, medium and light. Diane is also starting online

Election for First Vice-President and Treasurer for 2023. The nominees were Sherri for 1st. VP and Alicia for Treasurer. There were no additional nominations or write-ins. President Wendy took a vote by show of hands. The vote was unanimous electing Sherri for 1st VP and Alicia for Treasurer for 2023.

HPQG 2023 Budget - Sherri emailed the 2023 proposed budget to the membership on 11/5/2022. She informed the membership that a Scholarship Fund was included in the new budget to assist members needing financial help with dues. (Funds will be by donations only.) President Wendy took a vote by show of hands. The vote was unanimous, approving the 2023 budget.

Charity Quilts - Angie - Five quilts were delivered to the Hayworth Cancer Center in November. Anyone needing patterns, fabric or batting should please contact Angie.

Membership - Karen – Reminder that the 2023 membership dues have increased to \$35.00 and are due in January.
