



FRIENDSHIP STAR QUILT (45" X 60")

Fabric Requirements

Focus fabric (A) – 1 yard
 Background fabric (B) – 1 1/3 yards
 Accent fabric (C) – 1/3 yard
 Accent fabric (D) – 1/3 yard
 Backing fabric – 3 yards
 Binding fabric – 1/2 yard
 Batting – Twin size 72" x 93"

*You will make twelve 15"
 Friendship Star blocks*

Cutting Directions:

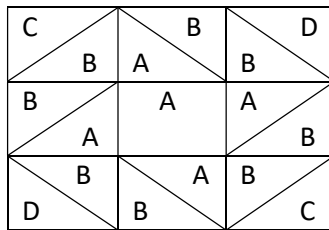
Focus fabric (A) – Cut: (12) 5 1/2" squares and (24) 5 7/8" squares
 Background fabric (B) – Cut: (48) 5 7/8" squares
 Accent fabric (C) – Cut: (12) 5 7/8" squares
 Accent fabric (D) – Cut: (12) 5 7/8" squares
 Binding – Cut: (6) 2 1/2" strips, width of fabric (total 220")

Preparation:

Layer (24) 5 7/8" (A) squares and (24) 5 7/8" (B) squares right sides together.
 Layer (12) 5 7/8" (B) squares and (12) 5 7/8" (C) squares right sides together.
 Layer (12) 5 7/8" (B) squares and (12) 5 7/8" (D) squares right sides together.
 Draw a diagonal line on one wrong side of each pair.

Constructions:

Sew 1/4" from each side of the line. Cut on the line.
 Press towards the darker fabric. Trim off the "dog ears."
 Layout the units, referring to the diagram.



Sew the units into rows. Press rows in opposite directions.

Sew the rows together. Press the seams away from the center row in six blocks (Stack A) and towards the center row in the remaining blocks (Stack B). This will aid in nesting seams when sewing the blocks into rows.

Layout the blocks 3 rows by 4 rows, alternating the blocks in Stack A and Stack B. Sew the blocks into rows. Press rows in opposite directions. Sew the rows together. Press in the same direction.

Layer up top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

Sew binding strips together. Press in half. Bind in preferred method.

Add label.
