April 14,2022

Beginning balance \$13,924.29, outstanding check \$25.00 rent for the new meeting site, \$40.00 deposit Raffle Quilt cash box, ending balance for March 2022 was \$13,899.29. A motion by Mary Beth Pazdernik, and seconded by Janet Wells to approve the March 2022 Treasurers Report was submitted. All in favor.

March 10, 2022 Meeting Minutes - Diantha Dann - A motion by Juanita Hale, seconded by Mary Beth Pazdernik to approve the March 10, 2022 minutes was submitted. All in favor.

Raffle Tickets - Mary Beth Pazdernik- The drawing for the quilt will be at our May 12, 2022 meeting. For any members that wish to purchase an envelope (30) of tickets before the drawing, the reduced price is \$15.00.
